Minutes of an Extra-Ordinary General Meeting
held at the Grand Hotel on Monday April 23rd
1928

On the Motion of Conte Faa di Bruno Mr. F.B. Keene was unanimously elected Chairman. Twenty members attended. The Notice convening the Meeting having been read, on the Motion of the Chairman the minutes of the previous General Meeting, it was agreed, should be taken as read & approved & were duly signed by the Chairman.

Conte Faa di Bruno on the motion of the Chairman then explained to the Meeting the position of affairs regarding the formation of the Italian Golf Federation.

All properly constituted Clubs would become Members of the Federation & would be called upon to subscribe annually an amount in proportion to the number of their Members. The principle of Elections of Committees would be abolished except in the case of foreign members who would be allowed to elect a certain proportion of the Committee. The President of the Federation would nominate the Italian Members of Committees. A standard system of handicapping would be introduced & fixture lists would be arranged so as to prevent clashing of dates.

President of the Federation

Conte Macchi moved that the hearty congratulations of the Meeting be tendered to Conte Faa di Bruno on his appointment as President of the Italian Golf Federation & also said that the Rome Golf Club was to be congratulated that the President should have been chosen from amongst their members.

This was unanimously carried.

Conte Faa di Bruno thanked the Meeting & proposed a hearty vote of thanks to the Chairman for presiding. Carried unanimously.
